

# GIVE-A-YEAR FOLLOWUP

- 1) We met 1:1 with each give-a-year soon after WMS to debrief their experience (see below).
- 2) We called an interest meeting for give-a-years to outline some “next step” strategies as a group (see below).
- 3) We continue to offer strategic moments (such as at our Winter Camp) for students to fill out a give-a-year commitment. We send these new names to Craig Woodham to be included in the Pipeline.
- 4) We continue to have followup meetings on a regular basis. I like the monthly strategy and curriculum that UVA uses.

In the 1:1, we ask these questions:

- Did you go forward?
- Where/What did you commit to do?
- Did you ask to be baptized in the Spirit?
- What did God do in your life at TWMS?
- Tell me about your daily devotional pattern before TWMS. What changes will you make?
- Which non-Christians are your friends on campus?
- What is your plan to lead them to Jesus?
- What steps will you take to prepare for the mission God gave you?

In the group meeting, we give these assignments:

- Consider giving a year in pairs;
- Attend missionary events over the next year (to meet additional missionaries);
- Focus on going where XA missionaries are ministering;
- Do the Live Dead journal challenge;
- Do a study on evangelism and global missions;
- Join an international prayer meeting in your XA group (or start one);
- Do the 21 Day Challenge by Jonathan Lytle;
- Ask their small group facilitator to give them weekly accountability;
- Juniors and seniors signed up for followup 1:1's with our staff point.
